Intern Role Description / Objectives for Children's Ministry Intern

Fellowship Bible Church

Purpose

The Fellowship Bible Church internship program exists to provide opportunities for young adults who are at least a year out of high school to explore a call to local church ministry. It will provide experience and training for learning, leading, and maintaining long-term ministry in the local church. The internship program is a 12-week, 40-hour-per-week, paid opportunity.

General Objectives

- Receive training and equipping for full-time, long-term church ministry.
- Receive training for a general understanding of theology and critical issues in ministry.
- Gain experience in full-time ministry in the local church.
- · Have opportunities to plan and lead ministry initiatives and programming.
- Develop one's character and spiritual life in order to sustain long-term ministry in the local church.
- Receive coaching in feedback to grow as a leader and minister.
- Have the opportunity to assess one's calling to local church ministry.
- Have various opportunities and exposure to ministries beyond one's assigned area to understand church-wide ministry, team vs. silo ministry dynamics, unique needs of cross-cultural ministry, etc.

- Biblical & Ministerial Training Sunday nights, 6–8 PM
- Life-on-Life Community Groups Tuesday mornings, 7:45–8:45 AM
- All-Staff Meetings Tuesday mornings, 9–10:45 AM

Ministry-Specific Objectives

- Gain knowledge in the vision and mission of Children's Ministry at Fellowship Bible Church.
- Receive training and coaching in recruiting volunteers, and developing volunteer teams in Children's Ministry.
- Gain experience and get feedback in all large group teaching for children.
- Gain experience in leading the Children's Ministry weekend experience as well as Super Kids Super Kamp (Summer Kids Camp) and events pertaining to Children's Ministry.
- Gain an understanding of child development and implement activities and teaching to better engage children at their age and stage of life with Scripture and life application.
- Gain knowledge in leading Children's Ministry in the local church.

Ministry-Specific Projects/Initiatives to be led by Intern

- Activities and games for Super Kids Super Kamp (June 2nd-June 5th)
- Coordinate weekend ministry for Children's Ministry
- Assist with leading and communications for promotion weekend June 6th/7th
- Lead and coordinate the weekend of June 27th/28th

Ministry-Specific Requirements

Be present each weekend of the summer from May 21st-August 9th, 2020

- One weekend absence is allowed and cannot be the weekend of May 30th/31st, June 6th/7th, June 27th/28th, or July 11th/12th, and will need to be approved by the Children's Ministry Director
- Must be present the week of June 2nd-June 5th
