

Student Ministry Intern Role Description / Objectives

Fellowship Bible Church

Purpose

The Fellowship Bible Church internship program exists to provide opportunities for young adults who are at least a year out of high school to explore a call to local church ministry. It will provide experience and training for learning, leading, and maintaining long-term ministry in the local church. The internship program is a 12-week, 40-hour-per-week, paid opportunity.

General Objectives

- Receive training and equipping for full-time, long-term church ministry.
- Receive training for a general understanding of theology and critical issues in ministry.
- Gain experience in full-time ministry in the local church.
- Have opportunities to plan and lead ministry initiatives and programming.
- Develop one's character and spiritual life in order to sustain long-term ministry in the local church.
- Receive coaching in feedback to grow as a leader and minister.
- Have the opportunity to assess one's calling to local church ministry.
- Have various opportunities and exposure to ministries beyond one's assigned area to understand church-wide ministry, team vs. silo ministry dynamics, unique needs of cross-cultural ministry, etc.

General Components

- Biblical & Ministerial Training - Sunday nights, 6–8 PM
- Life-on-Life Community Groups - Tuesday mornings, 7:45–8:45 AM
- All-Staff Meetings - Tuesday mornings, 9–10:45 AM

Ministry-Specific Objectives

- The Intern will work directly with the student ministry staff in planning, organizing, coordinating and in some cases leading the activities of the ministry.
- Assist in planning our Wednesday night (Surge) programming.
- Receive training and teach at Surge (at least one time).
- Assist in planning and leading our summer camp (July 30-August 3).
- Assist in making contacts with small group leaders, ministry group members, parents, and students in order to relay and follow up on specific events, ministry needs, projects and objectives.
- Assist with other general responsibilities, such as: activity and event preparation, participation in "on-stage" activities, planning for future growth, and correspondence with other ministries.
- Assist in our children's ministry's Super Kids Super Kamp (this is our kids camp...similar to VBS).
- Assist the student ministry team in planning, writing messages and small group questions.
