6. How far away is Nebraska City and will there be carpooling?

Nebraska City, NE is about 2 hours straight north on Hwy 75. When registering, you will have the option to request carpooling. This includes being a carpool driver or passenger. Our retreat team will connect you with others also interested in carpooling. The last carpool will leave Topeka at 4pm Friday night.

8. Who will be the speaker at the retreat?

Kristen Ainsworth will be speaking at this year's retreat. Here is a little bit about her story. In 2013, after nearly 10 years of marriage, Kristin found herself in a position she never dreamed she would be: a single mom of a 2-year old son. Through a season of deep suffering, the Lord not only sustained her, He transformed her. God used Kristen's suffering to expose sin in her own heart that she had been blind to for years, and she experience the joy of repentance and the beauty of God's grace. A community of godly women walked through this season of life with Kristen, and God taught the collectively how to pray, how to forgive, how to truly seek His face, and how to live with joy and hope in the midst of dark circumstances.

In 2015, Kristen and her son moved from Arkansas to Dallas, so Kristen could attend Dallas Theological Seminary and to be close to family. She is humbled and overjoyed to be a Groups Minister at The Village Church – Flower Mound, Flower Mound, TX, and to be part of the work the Lord is doing there.
